WEBSITE OF INCH NATIONAL SCHOOL:

Inch National School is committed to preserving the privacy of all visitors to **inchns.ias@eircom.net** ("our website"). This privacy statement relates to our practices in connection with our website and is designed to assist you in understanding how we collect, use and safeguard the personal information you provide to us and to assist you in making informed decisions when using our site and our services. Inch National School fully respects your right to privacy. We will not collect personal information/personal data about you when you visit our website unless you choose to provide that information using the "**Contact us**" form.

By using this site, you consent to the collection and use of your information under the terms of this privacy statement which is in accordance with the Data Protection Acts 1988 to 2018, the European Communities (Electronic Communications Networks and Services) (Privacy and Electronic Communications) Regulations 2011 and the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). Please read the following privacy statement to understand how we use and protect the information that you choose to provide to us.

WHAT INFORMATION DO WE COLLECT?

When you visit our website you may provide us with two types of information:

- Personal information you knowingly choose to disclose that is collected on an individual basis, and
- Statistical web site use information collected on an aggregate basis as you and others browse through our website(s)

INFORMATION, PERSONAL AND NON-PERSONAL, YOU CHOOSE TO PROVIDE

<u>Email address</u>

When you visit our website you may wish to provide certain information about yourself, such as when you complete our "*Contact Us*" form. Inch National School does not collect any personal data about you on this website, apart from the information which you volunteer to send us in the "*Contact Us*" form

Web Site Use Information

Where you visit our website, certain non-personal data is available to us through our internet service provider. This non-personal data is collected on a statistical, aggregate, non-individual basis. This information may include the IP address from which you access our website, the type of internet browser used to access our website, the type of operating system used to access our website, the type of operating system used to access our website, the type of our website, the "top-level" domain name used (ie, .com, .org, etc.), the date and time of your visit to our website and the number of pages you visited on our website

How Do We Use the Information That You Provide to Us?

Any information, which you provide using the "*Contact Us*" form, is not made available to any third parties and is only used by Inch National School in line with the purposes for which you provided it (e.g. to contact you and answer any queries which you have raised in the "*Contact Us*" form or to address any other feedback which you send us in the "*Contact Us*" form)

Disclosure to Other People:

We do not disclose, sell or distribute any personal information which you send to us to any third parties. We may pass aggregate information on the usage of our site to third parties, but this will not include information that can be used to identify you. Your personal data may also be anonymised and used for statistical purposes. Unless required to do so by law, we will not otherwise share, sell or distribute any of the information you provide to us without your consent.

IP Addresses:

An IP address is a number that is assigned to your computer automatically when you use the internet. When you visit any web page in our website, our servers log your IP address. We may use your IP address to help diagnose problems with our server and to administer our website. Your IP address is also used to help identify you and to gather broad demographic information.

WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Introduction

Cookies are small files placed on your computer's hard drive, or in your browser memory, when you visit Inch National School's website.

Our website uses cookies to help you in your interactions with the site and enhance your user experience. Our cookies don't store any personal or confidential information about you. To make sure you get the best experience from our website, we advise that users keep cookies active on their machine whilst visiting. Almost all websites use cookies and they have several different functions. The main purposes for cookies are to:

- 1. Allow the site to function correctly and to help keep it secure.
- 2. Make the site easier to use by remembering information that you've entered, to recognise you as a site user and to personalise your visit.
- 3. Collect basic information about the way you have used the site.

The cookies may also allow Inch National School to record additional information on the webpages you have visited and the contents of those webpages, any information you input, your referring URL or IP address, your time of visit and related session information, your requested page, web browser type, status of request (successful reply), cookies, number of bytes in the response, and query string and any information or technical detail your browser is sending to us.

Inch National School uses this information to better understand website usage in the aggregate so that we know what areas of our website users prefer. This information is stored in log files and is used for statistical reporting and in limited circumstances to prevent fraudulent claims.

What does this website specifically use cookies for?

Google Analytics: This is a common website tracking tool that provides us with general statistics about website usage, how people move around our site and the type of actions people take.
