Washing your hands is so important! Please wash them before you eat, after going to the toilet, if you sneeze or cough and when you come in from the playground. Make sure you use the sanitizer as you enter the classroom as well.



To keep you safe, your class will be your bubble. You will sit with some of your friends and you will stick together to help keep everyone safe. You can still talk to everyone, but you may not be able to sit beside them. Each class bubble will stick together, even in the playground. Because class bubbles have to stick together we won't see each other for big gatherings like our assemblies. You will still do all the fun things with your teacher, we will still have all our usual awards like star work and gaeilgeoir na miosa and you can still see all your friends.

You won't be able to share your things with your friends this year so make sure you have all your own pencils, pens, colours, scissors and glue with you every day before you come to school.
